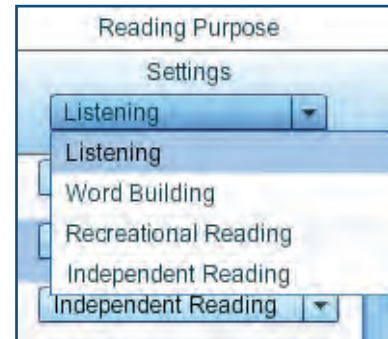




## Selecting a Reading Purpose

In **Preferences**, teachers can select pre-configured settings to meet specific needs of individual learners and build most-needed skills. Provided are configurations that combine settings targeted to listening comprehension, word-building, recreational reading and independent reading skills. Listed below are the settings for each configuration.



### Listening Settings

Designed to help build listening comprehension skills, readers listen to the narrator read each chapter aloud, and then complete quizzes with speech support. This builds motivation, vocabulary and background knowledge in material that may be above the readers' reading level.

## Word Building Settings

Readers follow along with the narrator. Then they can re-read each page independently using single-word help as needed. They take quizzes without speech support. Besides word recognition, readers build motivation, vocabulary, background knowledge and comprehension.

## Recreational Reading Settings

Readers listen to the narrator and/or read the story themselves for pleasure. There is no testing. Readers build motivation, vocabulary, background knowledge and comprehension.

## Independent Reading Settings

Readers read the book independently without audio support. Quizzes do not have speech support. However, speech support is available for single-word help. Teachers can assess the progress of their readers using quiz data and the collected words (words clicked on for help) report.
