What content is available from RFB&D?

- Over 61,000 titles.
 - Textbooks from core K-12 publishers, all grade levels
 - Literature award winning novels, classic novels, supplemental nonfiction titles to support report writing
- DAISY audio content in specialized subject areas read by human voice, complete with audio descriptions of figures, graphs
 - o Math
 - o Science
 - o Foreign language

How do I get textbooks from RFB&D?

- Search RFB&D's library at http://www.rfbd.org and click on Book Catalog
- Many of your students' needs are already available in accessible audio format
 - Audio titles available on CD or downloadable versions
- Note: Titles published prior to 8/16/2006 are generally not available through the NIMAC – in our catalog they're available **now** in navigable audio format!

NIMAS Book Ordering

Who is eligible to order NIMAS books from RFB&D?

- RFB&D school members
- · School contacts order for students with print disabilities who have an IEP

How do I order NIMAS books from RFB&D?

- If a student specifically requires a text version of their book, search the NIMAC repository at www.nimac.us to see if the book has already been submitted by the publisher for download
- If the book is in the NIMAC, email RFB&D at nimas@rfbd.org with the following information:
 - o Book title, author, publisher, ISBN
 - RFB&D member name and RFB&D ID for your school
 - State that the individual student requiring the book has an IEP and is therefore eligible for NIMAS books
- RFB&D will then download the files from the NIMAC, create a student-ready version of your book and ship them to your school on CD.

What is RFB&D's NIMAS product?

- A student-ready version of the electronic text of the book synchronized with synthetic audio, plus any images that the publisher provided.
- NIMAS books are delivered on CDs
- NIMAS books are played on specialized software for optimal use
 - The audio only portion of the NIMAS book can be played on the specialized hardware devices that we also offer for sale

What if my book is not listed in the NIMAC site?

- Check the copyright date of your book if 2006 or prior, publishers are not required to submit an electronic text version of the book to the NIMAC
- Search RFB&D's online catalog and order an accessible audio version of the book, as an interim option for your student
- Contact your district or state office responsible for purchasing books and let them know the title is needed in an electronic format
 - All textbook purchasing contracts should require the publisher to send NIMAS files to the NIMAC
- Once the book has been submitted to the NIMAC, email RFB&D with the information above and we'll create a student-ready NIMAS book for your student!
