

#### **Text Reader 1**

into Snap&Read

Reads PDFs and most text on websites

- 1. Click
- 2. Click the word where you want to start reading.
- 3. Click anywhere on the screen to stop reading.



#### **Text Reader 2**

Reads text that Text Reader 1 will not read

- 1. Click
- 2. Draw a box around the text you want to read.
- 3. If you want to stop reading, click anywhere in the box.



#### **Text Leveler**

Changes hard words to words that are easier to understand.

- 1. Highlight text you want to level.
- 2. Click
- 3. Easier words are shown in *italics*.
- 4. Click on words in *italics* to see the original word(s).

To add text to the outline and sources to the Bibliographer:

- 1. Click to open the **Note** tab.
- 2. Click **NEW** and type the name of the **Note**.
- 3. Highlight text you want to place in the outline.
- 4. Click A
- 5. The text goes into outline with its citation **and** the source is entered in the **Bibliographer**.
